



The **CAUSEWAY** programme has been developed as a means of helping to strengthen and improve relationships between young British and Irish people.

The programme is successfully administered through a close relationship between the two operational agencies Léargas (Republic of Ireland) and the Youth Council for Northern Ireland (UK).

Activities funded include : **Youth Exchanges** **Advance Planning Visits** **Contact Exchanges** **Special Projects**
